It was agreed to give copies of the questionnaire results to the Parish Council and Ian Hey.

Each Working Group will be given the complete excel spreadsheet to analyse the Survey results for their topic with a view to drafting proposals for the October meeting.

The Questionnaire working group will manage the program of events (agenda item 13).

Joe Dugdale seemed quite impressed with the results and encouraged us to continue – highlighting Green Spaces, Cycle Ways and new Proposals as ways of getting the SDDC to embrace our needs for the future.

Joe will disseminate guidance to the working groups next week and is happy to be contacted by the working groups to help with their draft proposals.

We have three winners for the Questionnaire Prize Draw. The Presentation will take place on 3 September at the Village Hall at 7pm.

7. Youth Club and John Port survey exercise.

This exercise did take place on 12 July but unfortunately there was another event that evening so only half of the children were around, and certainly not particularly engaged in hearing about future plans for the area. Some did agree to fill out the Questionnaire and returned them to us before the end date.

Joe Dugdale said this was something we needed to pursue again after the holidays, which we are intending to do, hopefully via John Port School, as these teenagers will be affected by the results of our Plan a few years down the line.
